## ARTICLE V

## OPFICERS

Section 1. Desionation. The orincipal officers of the Association shell be a Presijent, a Vice Presicent, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, all of whom shall be elected by the 3oard of Directors. The Board of Directors may apoint an Assistant Preasurer. end an Assistant Secretary, and such other officers as in their judgment may be necessary. Officers other than the president need not be Directors. The office of Secretary and Treasurer may be held by the same Person, but the office of president and Secretary may not be held by the same person.

Section 2. Election of officers. The officers of the Association shall be electect annually by the Board of Directors at the organization meeting of each new Board of Directors, and each officer shall hold his office at the pleasure of the zoard of directors, until he shall resign or be removed or otherwise disqualified to serve or his suecessor shall be elected and qualified to serve.

Section 3. Removal of officers. Upon an affirmative vote of a majority of the entire Board of Directors, any officer may temoved, either with or without cause at any regular meeting of the Board and his successor elected cial meeting of the Board of Directors Directors, or at any speAny officer may resign, at any time by called for such purpose. ne giving written notice to the such resignation shall take efferetary of the Association. Any notice or at any later time effect at the date of receipt of such wise specified in said notice specified therein; and unless otherthe Board shall not be note, acceptance of such resignation by

Section 4. Compensation. Officers, agents, and employees shall receive such reasonable commensation for their services as may be authorized or ratified by the Boardi provided, however, that no officer shall receive any compensation for services performed in the conduct of the Association's business unless such compensation is approved by the vote or witten consent of Members representing at least a majority of both the Class A and Class 3 voting power; and provided further, that (l) nothing herein contained shall be construed to preclude any officer from serving the Association in some other capacity and receiving compensation therefor, and (2) any officer may be reimbursed for his actual expenses incurted in the performance of his duties. Appointment of any officer, agent, or employee shall not of itself create contractual rights of compensation for services performed by such officer, agent, or emoloyee. Notwithstanding the foregoing, no officer, employee or director of Grantor or any affiliate of Grantor may receive any compensation.

Section 5. President. The President shall be the chief executive of Ficer of the Association. Ha shall greside at all aetings of the Association and of the goard of Directors. He shall have all of the general powers and duties which are usualiy vested in the office of the president of an Association, including but not limited to the power, subject to the provisions of article IV, Section 26, to appoint comittees trom among the fimbers from

time to time as he may in his discretion decide is aporogriate to assist in the conduct of the affairs of the Association. Tine presi dent shall, subject to the control of the Board of Directors, have general supervision, direction and control of the business of the Association. The president shall be ex officio a member of all standing commitrees, and he shall have such other powers and duties as may be prescribed by the Board of Directozs or these By-Laws of
the Association.

Section 6. Vice President. The Vice President shall take the place of the president and perforn his duties whenever the President shall be absent, disabled, refuses or unable to act. If neither the president nor the vice president is able to act, the Soard of Directors sinall appoint sone other member of the Board to do so on an interim besis. The Vice Presicent sinall also perform such other duties as shall from tine to time be imposed upon him by the Board of Directors or these By-Laws of the Association.

Section 7 . Secretary. The Secretary shall keep the minutes of all meetings of the Board of Directors and the Minutes of all ation or at such other place as the Board of Directors may order. The Secretary shall keep the seal of the Associaeion in safe custody and shall have charge of such books and papers as the Soard of Directors may direct; and the secretary shall, in general, gerform all of the duties incident to the office of secretary. The Secretary shall give, or cause to be given, notices of meetings of the Members of the Association and of tie Board of Directors reguired by these sy-Laws or by law to be given. The secretary shall maintain a record book of Unit Owners, listing the names and addresses of Unit Owners, as fucnished to the Association, and such books shall be changed only at such time as satisfactory evidence of a change in ownership of a condominium is zresented to the Secretary, The Secretary shall perform such other duties as may be prescribed by the Eoard of Directors or these ay-Laws.

Section $B$ - Treasures- The Treastrer shall have responsibility for Association Euncs and securities and shall be responsible for keeping, or causing to be kept, full and accurate accounts, tax records and business transactions of the Association, including accounts of all assets, liabilities, receipts and disbursements in books belonging to the Association. The Treasurer shall be resoonsible for the deposit of all monies and other valuable effects in the nane, and to the credit, of the Association in such depositories as may from time to time be designazed oy the Board of Directors. The mreasurer shall disburse the funds of tire Association as may be ordered by the Poard of Directors, in accordance with the Declaration, shall render to the President and Directors, upon request, an account of all of his transactions as Treasurer end of the financial conditions of the Association, and shall have such other powers and perform such other duties as may be prescribed sy the Board of Directors or these By-Laws.
